Now we are faced with our next challenge. Unfortunately, Hurricane Laura has impacted the industry's resin supply. At this time, the customer's demand for PVC conduit, fittings and boxes is exceeding the PVC manufacturer's ability to supply products.

This is actually a good news, bad news scenario. The good news is that we have enough business to continue running all CANTEX operations full out. The bad news is that we cannot manufacture enough product to keep up with customer orders.

The sales team has developed a strategy to manage the overwhelming order entry by implementing the following:

- 1. Only taking pipe orders from customers who have been supporting CANTEX.
- 2. Not taking on new pipe customers until the demand returns to a normal operating level.
- 3. Controlling order size based on the customer's purchasing history.

We expect the demand for our products to continue at a similar pace through the end of the year and perhaps into 2021. The markets that we serve remain very busy, adding to the very high demand for our products. Construction of single family homes, apartments, data centers, and roads is extensive nationwide. Similarly, the power utility and retail markets are also flourishing.
